From here, you can see Megiddo in the distance, the ancient city mentioned in the Book of Revelation. As we approach Nazareth, the Mount of Precipitation comes into view, where according to Luke 4:28-30, an angry crowd attempted to throw Jesus from the cliff.

Nazareth Tour: The Church of the Annunciation

The **Nazareth and Sea of Galilee tour from Tel Aviv** also allows for reflection on the deep historical significance of these sites. The first major stop on this **Nazareth and Sea of Galilee tour** is the Church of the Annunciation, built on the spot where the Angel Gabriel appeared to Mary. This modern basilica, completed in 1969, incorporates remains of earlier Byzantine and Crusader churches. The lower level preserves the traditional site of Mary's home.

Next door stands the Church of St. Joseph, constructed over what tradition holds was Joseph's carpentry workshop. Your guide explains the archaeological findings and the layers of history visible in these sacred spaces.

From Cana to the Sea of Galilee Tour

A visit to Capernaum is essential during your **Nazareth and Sea of Galilee tour from Tel Aviv**, enriching your understanding of Jesus' life.

Leaving Nazareth, your **Galilee tour from Tel Aviv** continues through Cana, where Jesus performed his first miracle by turning water into wine at a wedding feast (John 2:1-12). The road then descends toward the Sea of Galilee, and the landscape transforms as you approach this freshwater lake that sits 200 meters below sea level.

The sea itself is smaller than many expect, just 21 kilometers long, but its significance in the Gospels is immense. This is where Jesus calmed the storm, walked on water, and called Peter, Andrew, James, and John to follow him.

Sea of Galilee Tour: Capernaum and Sacred Sites

No **Nazareth and Sea of Galilee tour** is complete without visiting Capernaum, called "the town of Jesus" in the Gospels. Here you see the ruins of a 4th-century synagogue built over the one where Jesus taught. Nearby, a modern church hovers over the excavated remains of St. Peter's house.

The Church of the Multiplication marks where Jesus fed 5,000 people with five loaves and two fishes (Mark 6:30-44). The original 5th-century mosaic floor depicting loaves and fishes remains one of the finest examples of Byzantine art in Israel. The southern shore brings us to [Yardenit](#), where the Jordan River flows out of the Sea of Galilee. This peaceful site offers the opportunity to participate in a baptism ceremony in the same river where John baptized Jesus (Mark 1:9-11). White robes are available for purchase or rent. For baptism arrangements with a priest, contact Yardenit directly in advance. Our estimated visit time at Yardenit is 15:30-16:15.
